CONDITIONS OF SHOW
Saturday, October 11, 2008

Participation Criteria

- Application is required for consideration.
- Applications must be received at JCL Community Health Center, 9221 N Central Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85020, or via email to artwalk@sunnyslopecommunity.org no later than **3 p.m. on Friday, August 8, 2008.**
- An application is an artist's commitment to show.
- Participation is restricted to accepted artists selected by Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays committee. Selected artists will be notified by **Monday, September 8, 2008.**
- Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays retains the right to use photos submitted by the artist for use in advertising and promotion of the event.

Artist Criteria

- All work must be original and completely finished.
- All art must be for sale.
- No dealers or sales representatives are allowed.
- Information booths are not permitted.

Set Up Guidelines

- Exhibit space is assigned. One space will be approximately 8' long and 10' deep.
- Power, or access to power, is not guaranteed.
- Personal generators are NOT permitted.
- Artist may only show work typified by the application.
- Artist is responsible for providing all elements of the display and shall be responsible for delivery, handling, erection, and removal of their own displays and materials.
- Artists may begin to set up as early as 2 p.m. on the day of the show.
- Set up must be complete and all vehicles must be removed from the display area no later than 4:30 p.m.
- Exhibit must remain open and attended from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m.
- Artist is responsible for keeping their area clean during show hours, including clean-up at the end of the event.
- All exhibits, goods, and materials must be removed and the area clean by 10pm.

Rules and Regulations

- Artist must personally attend his/her exhibit and be present during the entire show. Representatives may not attend in place of the artist. Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays reserves the right to request photo identification to ensure compliance with this rule.
- All art items displayed must be for sale.
- Live art demonstrations may only be performed by approved artists.
- The Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays committee, reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to deem any work inappropriate and may demand the item in question be removed from display immediately as a condition of continued participation.
- Artist and their assistants must exhibit professional behavior at all times while on the Art Walk site. Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine what constitutes professional behavior. Violation of this rule will result in the exhibitor, their assistants, and exhibits being removed.
- All pertinent fire codes, laws, ordinances and regulations pertaining to health, fire prevention and public safety shall be strictly obeyed.
- Artist is responsible for collection and remittance of any required sales tax.
- Insurance, if desired, must be obtained by the artist at their own cost. Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays and property owners are not responsible for any of the artist's works.
- Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays reserves the right to revoke the permission granted by this contract at any time, including at the event. Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays will not be liable for paying any travel expenses, lost revenue, or any other liability as a result of enforcing this provision.
- Participation constitutes as an agreement between Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays and the exhibitor and no deviation shall be permitted unless otherwise documented in writing and signed by the parties or their representatives.
- Artist, by signing this application, will hereby release and forever discharge Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays and all sponsoring organizations and their directors, officers, employees, agents, and volunteers from any responsibility, personal liability, claims, loss or damage arising out of or in conjunction with his/her participation in the October 11th Sunnyslope Art Walk. Sunnyslope 2nd Saturdays and all sponsoring organizations will not be responsible for any injury sustained by the artist and/or guests while within area designated for exhibits. Further, artist understands that he/she stores and shows his/her artwork at his/her own risk.
