About the Safe Drug Disposal Event

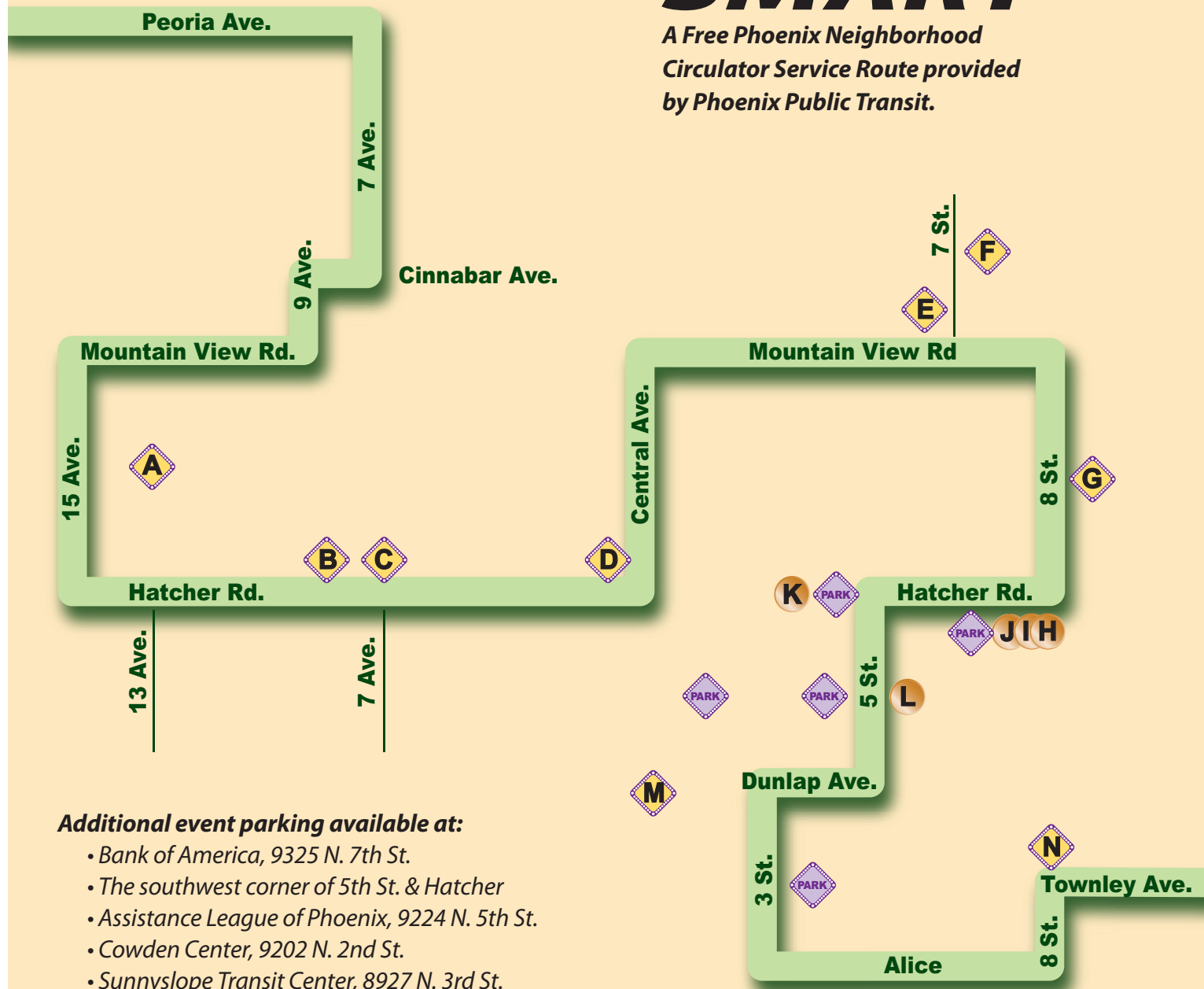

I. Sunnyslope Historical Society (737 E. Hatcher Rd.) Sunnyslope has its own museum housed in the old People's Pharmacy building, which brought the first drive-through window to the state of Arizona! Celebrate the rich history of this community by visiting the Historical Society exhibits and see a special vintage car display.

J. Literacy Volunteers of Maricopa County (729 E. Hatcher Rd.) Sunnyslope has its own adult education center where people can prepare for the GED and learn to speak English for FREE! Celebrate it with tours of the facility. There will be games for children to win book prizes too.
